- Sat. June 5** **Outdoor Knot Tying, 1pm.** Meet at the Nature Center to learn some useful outdoor knots.
- Sat. June 12** **Night Hike & Owl Prowl 9pm.** Meet at the picnic shelter near the camp check-in and join the Naturalist on a 1-mile nocturnal hike in search of Ohio's nighttime animals. *Flashlights optional, no pets please. Weather dependent.*
- Sun. June 20** **Father's Day Hike, 9am.** Grab Dad and meet at the Morgan's Knob/ Pinecrest Parking lot and go on a brisk .8mile guided morning hike to celebrate Father's Day. *Sturdy footwear and bug spray recommended. Weather dependent.*
- Sat. June 26** **Salt Fork Squatching, 7pm.** Meet at the picnic shelter near the camp check-in for a fireside chat with local bigfoot researchers before the Bigfoot Night Hike. *Weather dependent.*
- Bigfoot Night Hike, 8pm (Families), 9:30pm (Adults).** Meet at the shelter house near camp check-in and go in search of Bigfoot at Salt Fork State Park and learn about the legend of the Ohio Grassman. *Flashlights optional, no pets please. Weather dependent.*
- Wed. June 30** **Litter Pick-up, 9am-12pm.** A little litter is a big problem. Meet at Salt Fork Marina and help with this litter pick up. Please call or email the Naturalist for more information and to pre-register for this event. *Trash-bags, gloves, etc. provided. Weather dependent.*
